2009-2010 Mission Trips/Projects

Please mark beside the name of the Mission Trip/Project you are signing up for. Remember, some of these trips have limited spaces, so please get your application turned in ASAP:

- Uruguay Mission Trip - May 16th - 30th (possibility to stay all summer) - \$1900 -** Even though Uruguay is one of the most beautiful countries in South America to visit, it remains the most secular nation in North or South America (around 2-3% evangelical Christian). FBC took its first trip to Uruguay last summer, sharing Christ with students and families in 3 different cities. This year FBC is returning to reach people for Christ through Sports (specifically softball) & community outreach while partnering with local churches.
- Brazil Mission Trip - June 6th - 19th - \$2200 (possibility to stay all summer) -** Believe it or not, there are still a few billion people who have never heard the name of Jesus. Some of these people groups live in some extremely remote places. For this reason, FBC has taken several trips in the past to Brazil to share the Gospel with unreached peoples along the Amazon River. With the help of a translator, you have the chance to go visit villages as you travel (and sleep) on a boat.
- FBC Family Mission Trip, Canyon City, CO - July 15th - 22nd - \$200 -** Over the last 5 years, FBC Russellville has started a tradition known as the family mission trip. In this mission trip, FBC sends dozens of their members to work with local churches to reach an area for Christ through sports camps, block parties, concerts, and evangelism. Come be a part of this tradition and help reach the Canyon City community for Christ.
- Kenya Mission Trip - July 18th - 31st - \$3800 -** FBC Russellville has been coming to this part of Kenya for over 10 years now. Recently, FBC was able to help financially with the construction of a training facility for Kenyan pastors. You can have the opportunity to share the message of hope found in Jesus with the Keiyo people group by memorizing Bible stories and sharing them with the help of a translator in Keiyo villages
- M.A.P.S. Project, San Diego, CA - May 29th - July 24th - \$1900 -** MAPS stands for Missions And Prayer School, and this college student discipleship project will challenge you to be more like Jesus. Hosted in San Diego along the west coast, this experience helps you to grow in prayer, time with God, obedience to Christ, living in community with other believers, and sharing Christ with others.
- Overseas Summer Missions Project - May 24th - July 25th (destination and dates tba) - \$5000 -** This is the experience that many of you have been waiting for; a chance to go make a difference in the lives of college students in another part of the world where Jesus is not well known. The cost includes a one week orientation week in Kansas to get you ready to serve in a foreign culture. Cost also includes every other expense you would have (minus souvenirs of course). This trip is demanding, but it gives an opportunity to impact lost college students with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- FBC College Leadership Project, Russellville, AR - May 24th - July 25th - (final dates & cost tba) -** Join Mark Palfreeman in a journey to what it means to be a leader who serves from a heart that loves Jesus. This intensive leadership training project will prepare you to be a follower of Christ who is a disciplemaker like Jesus. This project specifically trains students to serve in FBC College servant team during the school year.
